This meeting led him signing a deal with the company and then later to Asylum / Warner Music Group.

While working with numerous Grammy nominated and award winning artists and musicians such as DJ Khaled and many others. Homebwoi achieved massive success even during the difficulties he faced in the music industry. Over the course of the years, Homebwoi received numerous accolades and features in very esteemed publications. Recently he embarked on his latest ground breaking project, a tell all documentary about his life and career entitled, "How To Tame An Elephant" - this film reveals the struggles and triumphs during his journey to stardom and an in depth look to his family structure and those who were instrumental in his career.
